MONTHLY BOARDING AT LONE TREE

BARN – Covered paddocks or stalls, and large grassy turnout. Feed twice or more per day, all the horse will eat (or as needed for the horse's requirements). Cleaning, salt, blanketing, vet and farrier, scheduling, and handling. Board includes up to 8 bags of shavings for initial bedding; \$10/bale charged for extra. **\$640**

PASTURE– Feed hay as needed in the cold season, salt, blanketing, vet and farrier scheduling and handling. **\$425*** (Additional charges apply for horses that require extra feed.)

*Winter month hay surcharge applies in Winter months (Dec-March) \$1/per day. (Approximately \$30 per month)

Please note, that in order to accommodate our waiting list, we require 30 days notice to terminate boarding agreement.
